







EMS OPERATIONS DURING THE FIRST DAYS OF THE FULL-SCALE INVASION

During the first days of the war, the EMS Center operated continuously in emergency mode, implementing defensive measures. To ensure uninterrupted operations during air alerts, backup dispatch points were organized in shelters.





WORK OF EMS TEAMS DURING THE WAR

The teams operated in high-risk conditions, evacuating people via "green corridors", transporting the wounded, and providing assistance in combat zones.





ENSURING COMMUNICATION AND UNINTERRUPTED OPERATIONS

Due to the lack of radio communication, we sought alternatives for stable communication during signal disruptions and electronic warfare (EW). We used the Starlink system and backup channels via messengers. In conditions of unstable power supply, we operated on diesel generators. Over time, humanitarian aid improved the situation by providing additional power sources.

RESILIENT OPERATIONS OF EMS TEAMS

To ensure the constant readiness of the teams in combat conditions, supply kits for several days were organized, including sleeping arrangements, food, and water. The teams operated in dangerous areas, exposed to risks, particularly in locations under enemy shelling.











PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

Medical personnel were provided with special protective equipment: gas masks, chemical protection gear, and specialized equipment to ensure safety.







TRAINING AND EDUCATION DEPARTMENT

After the suspension of air medical evacuation, the Education and Training Department shifted its focus to internal training, including adaptation and development. Regular training for medical personnel is essential for effective operations during the war, especially in bordering areas such as tactical medicine.

MILITARY TRAINING

Specialized training for the military included courses on tactical medicine and first aid on the battlefield.






